Resolution 2022-34

WHEREAS, Crawford County semi-annually completes an inspection of all bridges on the Secondary Road System of Crawford County and

WHEREAS, part of this inspection involves the recalculation of the safe load capacity of any structure showing significant deterioration of the structural components of that structure and

WHEREAS, that structural evaluation has resulted in the recommendation to reduce the safe load capacity that can be supported by certain structures,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Crawford County Board of Supervisors on this 20th day of December 2022 as provided in Sections 321.471, 321.472 and 321.473, Code of Iowa, to erect and/or maintain weight limit signs in advance of the following bridges located on the Federal Aid, Farm-to-Market, and Local Secondary Road System as follows:
