Tree and brush removal from County Right-Of-Way

THIS FORM IS FOR INFORMATION ONLY, IT DOES NOT GIVE PERMISSION FOR CONTRACTOR TO WORK IN COUNTY RIGHT-OF-WAY. CONTRACTOR MUST GO TO COUNTY ENGINEERS OFFICE IN COURTHOUSE WITH PROOF OF LIABILITY INSURANCE AND SIGN APPROVED APPLICATION FORM BEFORE ANY WORK IS PERFORMED.

NO PAYMENTS WILL BE MADE UNLESS APPLICATION FORM IS APPROVED AND SIGNED BY COUNTY ENGINEER

AGREEMENTS: The individual Contractor hereby agrees to the following stipulations:

1. The removal and disposal of cleared and grubbed material shall meet the requirements of local municipal, county, state and federal laws, and regulations.
2. Contractor agrees to give the Crawford County Engineer's Office 48 hours notice of the Contractor's intention to start any removals on the road right of way.
3. Contractor shall take all reasonable precautions during the removal and disposal of said cleared and grubbed material and safeguard the lives and property of the traveling public and adjacent property owners. Contractor's operations in removal and disposal of said cleared and grubbed materials shall be carried on so as to cause a minimum of interference to traffic on said roadway. The Contractor shall be responsible for installing the proper road signs to protect the traveling public. Crawford County will furnish the signs, but the Contractor will have to pick them up at the County Shop in Denison and return them in the same condition after completion of the work.
4. The Contractor shall indemnify and save harmless Crawford County, Iowa, from any and all causes of action, suits at law, or losses, damages, claims, or demands, and from any and all liability and expense whatsoever for, on account of, or due to acts or omissions of said Contractor and or said Contractor's agents, representatives, officers, members, sub-contractors, employees, or assigns, arising out of or in connection with Contractor's use or occupancy of the public roadway under this permit.
5. Contractor shall comply with any special provisions noted on the attached map.
6. The Contractor shall submit to the Crawford County Engineer's Office a certificate of liability and property insurance, with the minimum coverage as follows: General Liability Insurance – Bodily Injury and Property Damage combined \$500,000 Each Occurrence/\$1,000,000 Aggregate. Automobile Liability - \$500,000 Combined Single Limits. Excess Liability – Part A – Statutory, Part B - \$500,000/\$500,000/\$500,000.
7. Upon completion of the removal operations within the right-of-way all disturbed areas shall be restored to pre-removal condition, or better, by filling, cutting and shaping. All work shall be done in a workmanlike manner, and the ground left in a neat condition, satisfactory to the County Engineer or his representative. Contractor shall be responsible for any damage that may result to said roadway because of clearing and grubbing operation.
8. Seeding of disturbed areas within the right-of-way will be completed by Crawford County.
9. The Contractor shall be responsible for locating a suitable disposal area for cleared and grubbed material removed from within the right-of-way and hauling all materials to said disposal area.
10. Measurement and payment for clearing and grubbing within the right-of-way shall be as follows:
A representative from the Crawford County Engineer's Office shall determine the location of the right-of-way line by an on site inspection of the area to be cleared, and a review of records pertaining to right-of-way widths in said area. The County will not complete a detailed boundary survey.
A representative from the Crawford County Engineer's Office shall count the number of units of clearing and grubbing within the right-of-way using the Iowa Department of Transportation Statement of Clearing and Grubbing form.
11. Payment to the Contractor for clearing and grubbing within the right-of-way shall be made at the rate of \$3.00 per clearing and grubbing unit on areas adjacent to gravel roads, and \$1.00 per clearing and grubbing unit on areas adjacent to dirt roads. Following completion of the work, the Contractor will be required to submit an invoice to the Crawford County Engineer's Office for the total amount of clearing and grubbing as shown on the schedule.
12. The Contractor shall notify ONE-CALL (1-800-292-8989) for utility locates prior to commencing work.
13. The Crawford County Engineer has the right to approve or reject all applications.

APPLICATION TO CLEAR AND GRUB TREES FROM COUNTY ROAD RIGHT OF WAY

CRAWFORD COUNTY, IOWA

The contractor named below hereby makes application-requesting permission to clear and grub trees from certain portions of road right of way located as follows:

_____ and as shown on the attached map which is hereby made a part of.

AGREEMENTS: The individual Contractor hereby agrees that the following stipulations shall govern under this permit.

1. The removal and disposal of cleared and grubbed material shall meet the requirements of local municipal, county, state and federal laws, and regulations.
2. Contractor agrees to give the Crawford County Engineer's Office 48 hours notice of the Contractor's intention to start any removals on the road right of way.
3. Contractor shall take all reasonable precautions during the removal and disposal of said cleared and grubbed material and safeguard the lives and property of the traveling public and adjacent property owners. Contractor's operations in removal and disposal of said cleared and grubbed materials shall be carried on so as to cause a minimum of interference to traffic on said roadway. The Contractor shall be responsible for installing the proper road signs to protect the traveling public. Crawford County will furnish the signs, but the Contractor will have to pick them up at the County Shop in Denison and return them in the same condition after completion of the work.
4. The Contractor shall indemnify and save harmless Crawford County, Iowa, from any and all causes of action, suits at law, or losses, damages, claims, or demands, and from any and all liability and expense whatsoever for, on account of, or due to acts or omissions of said Contractor and or said Contractor's agents, representatives, officers, members, sub-contractors, employees, or assigns, arising out of or in connection with Contractor's use or occupancy of the public roadway under this permit.
5. Contractor shall comply with any special provisions noted on the attached map.
6. **The Contractor shall submit to the Crawford County Engineer's Office a certificate of liability and property insurance, with the minimum coverage as follows: General Liability Insurance – Bodily Injury and Property Damage combined \$500,000 Each Occurrence/\$1,000,000 Aggregate. Automobile Liability - \$500,000 Combined Single Limits. Excess Liability – Part A – Statutory, Part B - \$500,000/\$500,000/\$500,000.**
7. Upon completion of the removal operations within the right-of-way all disturbed areas shall be restored to pre-removal condition, or better, by filling, cutting and shaping. All work shall be done in a workmanlike manner, and the ground left in a neat condition, satisfactory to the County Engineer or his representative. Contractor shall be responsible for any damage that may result to said roadway because of clearing and grubbing operation.
8. Seeding of disturbed areas within the right-of-way will be completed by Crawford County.
9. The Contractor shall be responsible for locating a suitable disposal area for cleared and grubbed material removed from within the right-of-way and hauling all materials to said disposal area.
10. Measurement and payment for clearing and grubbing within the right-of-way shall be as follows:
A representative from the Crawford County Engineer's Office shall determine the location of the right-of-way line by an on site inspection of the area to be cleared, and a review of records pertaining to right-of-way widths in said area. A detailed boundary survey will not be completed by the County.
A representative from the Crawford County Engineer's Office shall count the number of units of clearing and grubbing within the right-of-way using the Iowa Department of Transportation Statement of Clearing and Grubbing form.
11. Payment to the Contractor for clearing and grubbing within the right-of-way shall be made at the rate of \$3.00 per clearing and grubbing unit on areas adjacent to gravel roads, and \$1.00 per clearing and grubbing unit on areas adjacent to dirt roads. Following completion of the work, the Contractor will be required to submit an invoice to the Crawford County Engineer's Office for the total amount of clearing and grubbing as shown on the schedule.
12. The Contractor shall notify ONE-CALL (1-800-292-8989) for utility locates prior to commencing work.
13. The Crawford County Engineer has the right to approve or reject all applications.
