No. 18-20 – West Central Iowa Rural Water Association – installation of 2.5" Water Service line along the west side of 350th St commencing at 1585 350th St. thence south 2200 feet along 350th St. to 1639 350th St.

No. 18-21 – Western Iowa Power Coop – installation of underground electric cable along the west side of 400th St. commencing at a point 2450 feet south of the intersection with N Ave. thence south 5755 feet to a point 2355 feet north of the intersection with O Ave.
