The Board of Supervisors met at 9:00 o'clock A.M. with Jeri Vogt, Chairperson presiding. All members were present.

Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

On motion, the Board recognized claims for the Public Health Department and approved claims for all other departments.

The Board approved the change of wage for Derek Hoyle, Maintenance Employee II in the Engineer's Office.

The Board approved the following Underground Utility Permits:

No. 21-19 – Western Iowa Power Coop – primary underground crossing 380th St. at a point 4090 feet south of the intersection with H Ave.

No. 21-20 – Frontier Communications – Boring channel at bridge located on 150th St. just south of the intersection with Hwy 141.

The sum of One Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,200,000) is hereby transferred from the Rural Basic Fund #0011 into the Secondary Road Fund #0020

Resolution Establishing Special Revenue Fund No. 3019 (American Rescue Plan Act Fund)

WHEREAS, Crawford County has determined the need to establish a special revenue fund for accounting purposes of depositing revenue and paying expenditures for the maintenance and other costs related to the American Rescue Plan Act.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the American Rescue Plan Act Fund – Special Revenue Fund No. 3019, be and is hereby established as of June 22, 2021.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that interest shall accrue to said fund as is normally allocated and computed by the Crawford County Treasurer.

Voting Aye: Heiden, Rosburg, Schultz, Skoog, and Vogt. Motion passed unanimously.

The Board held a discussion on wind turbines. Many residents were present in person and via Zoom to voice their concerns. Representatives from the Silver Queen Wind Turbine project were also present.

The Board discussed the need for a new Wind Turbine Ordinance or an amendment to the current zoning ordinance. No action was taken at this time.
