Monroe 12' reversible plow, Monroe 9' wing assembly, hydraulic controls, mounting and painting from Hawkeye Truck Equipment for \$144,039.00 each for a total of \$288,078.00. To be paid for in FY 2025, subject to budget approval.

Motion passed unanimously.

The Board met with Mariah Nutt and Drew Perrien of the CDC for the Quarterly Tourism Report.
